Position Summary:

The overall objective of midwifery care is to provide safe, flexible maternity care to childbearing families that is centered on the needs of the woman and her family. Midwives are autonomous practitioners who provide midwifery service to women in a variety of settings such as in the client's home, in community clinics, and in hospitals. Midwives work collaboratively with other professionals and function as members of a multidisciplinary health care team to provide effective, comprehensive midwifery service to childbearing women and their families. Midwifery care is provided to the woman and her newborn until six (6) weeks postpartum. The midwife facilitates continuity of access to care beyond the childbearing year, when necessary, through communication with other care providers or services.

Qualifications:

- Must be registered or eligible for registration with the College of Midwives of Manitoba
- Graduate of an educational program approved by the College of Midwives of Manitoba
- Current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and neonatal resuscitation certification (NRP) with intubation required
- Experience working with priority populations
- Ability to work flexible hours
- Acceptance of work-related travel, a valid driver's license and access to a vehicle
- Good work and attendance record
