Brandon, Manitoba, located in Southern Manitoba, has a culturally diverse population of 45,000 and a total population of surrounding area of about 150,000. We are in close proximity to year round recreational areas of Riding Mountain National Park, and Spruce Woods and Turtle Mountain Provincial Parks for cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, boating and canoeing, water skiing, hiking etc. There are many recreational opportunities and cultural events to be enjoyed year round. Brandon is home to Brandon University, which is renowned for its music program and Assiniboine Community College.

Brandon Regional Health Authority is currently recruiting a Midwife to fill a full time position. This individual will offer both home and hospital birthing options and work collaboratively with other professionals and function as a member of a multidisciplinary health care team. The Brandon Midwifery practice operates within a shared-cared model, which allows for time off-call and facilitates a balance between work and personal life. A full-time midwife as per the College of Midwives of Manitoba (CMM) is expected to serve at least 30 clients per year. Currently the salary ranges from \$36.35 to \$42.58 and payment is issued bi-weekly. Employees of the Brandon Regional Health Authority are offered an extended health benefits package. Midwives are unionized in Manitoba. In accordance with CCM, the supervision period for new registrants is usually 6 months. All services will be delivered in accordance with policies and procedures of Brandon RHA, the Midwifery Model of Practice and the Standards of the College of Midwives of Manitoba. The successful candidate will possess the following qualifications:

### **REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Graduate of an educational program approved by the College of Midwives of Manitoba (CMM)
- Eligible for registration by the CMM
- Eligible to obtain admitting privileges at BRHC
- Eligible for liability insurance coverage specified by the Brandon RHA
- Ability to function as a member of an interdisciplinary team
- Ability to work flexible hours and on call schedule
- Current BLS or BLS Instructor certification within the past 12 months
- Current Neonatal Resuscitation (NRP) certification with intubation
- Valid driver's license and access to a vehicle
- Advanced level of written and oral communication skills
- Strong organizational, decision making and problem solving skills
- Ability to display independent judgment
- Ability to work with all staff
- Ability to respect and promote a culturally diverse population
- Ability to respect and promote confidentiality
- Ability to perform the duties of the position on a regular basis

**The successful candidate will be subject to a Criminal Records Check and a Child Abuse Registry Check and be responsible for any service charges incurred.**
