POLICY RELATED TO INITIAL REGISTRATION DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Effective May 1, 2020 to October 1, 2020

To enhance midwifery resources in Manitoba in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the CMM has temporarily revised its policies related to initial registration as a practising midwife or exam candidate.

The temporary changes recognize that recent graduates may suitably practice midwifery without risk to the public after completing the revised requirements in conjunction with the requirements in the undertaking below as well as the conditions of the New Registrant policy and, where applicable, conditions of Exam Candidate registration.

The following table highlights the registration requirements where there has been a change in policy.
