STANDARD ON CONTINUING COMPETENCY IN FETAL HEALTH SURVEILLANCE

The midwife will have completed an educational session/workshop in Fetal Health Surveillance (FHS) every two (2) years.

Where a midwife is a certified FHS instructor they will be considered to have met the above requirements by providing evidence of having taught at least one FHS course in the previous 24 months.

The midwife will present evidence of having met the requirements upon annual renewal of registration.

Acceptable courses include:

- Fundamentals of Fetal Health Surveillance (in-person course/refresher, online exam or self-learning manual)
- AWHONN Fetal Health Monitoring Course
- Other courses considered equivalent by the Quality Assurance Committee
